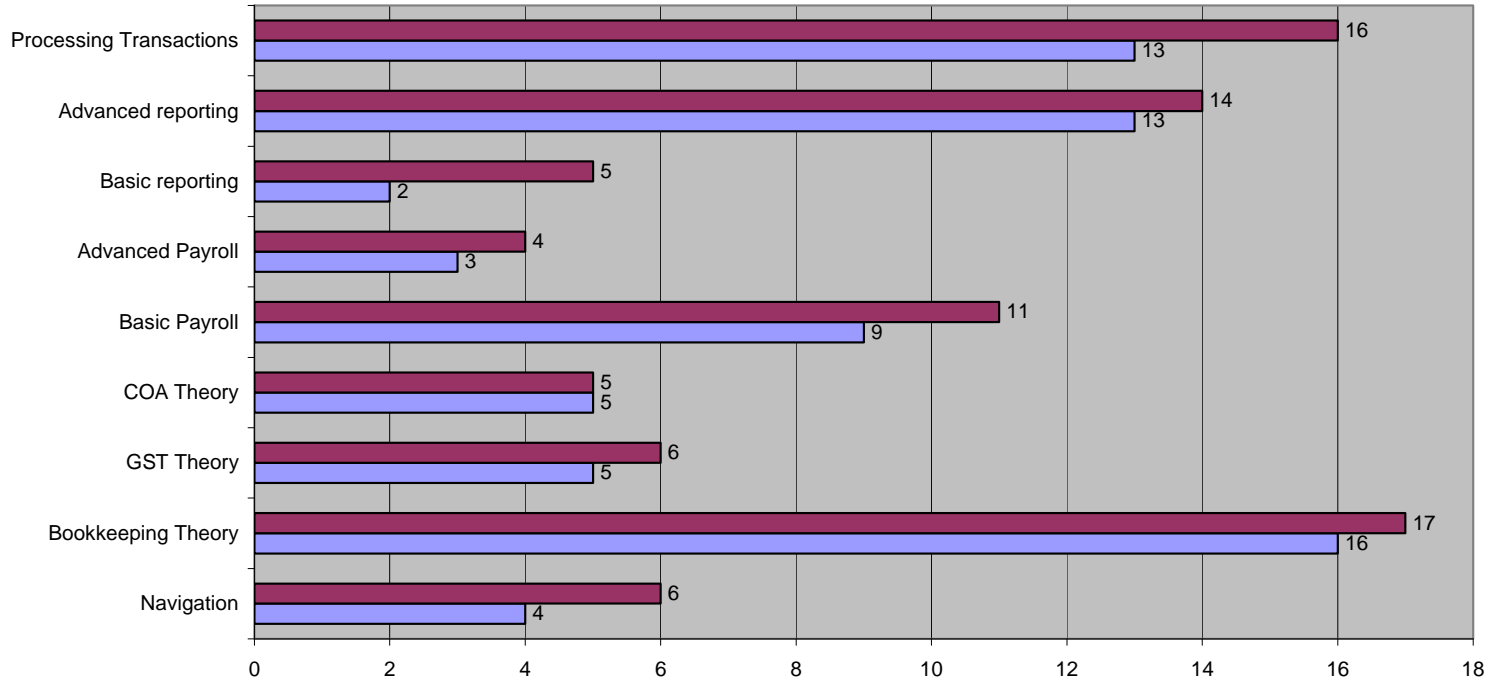
Parikshit lives in North Coburg. He is seeking a part time work.
